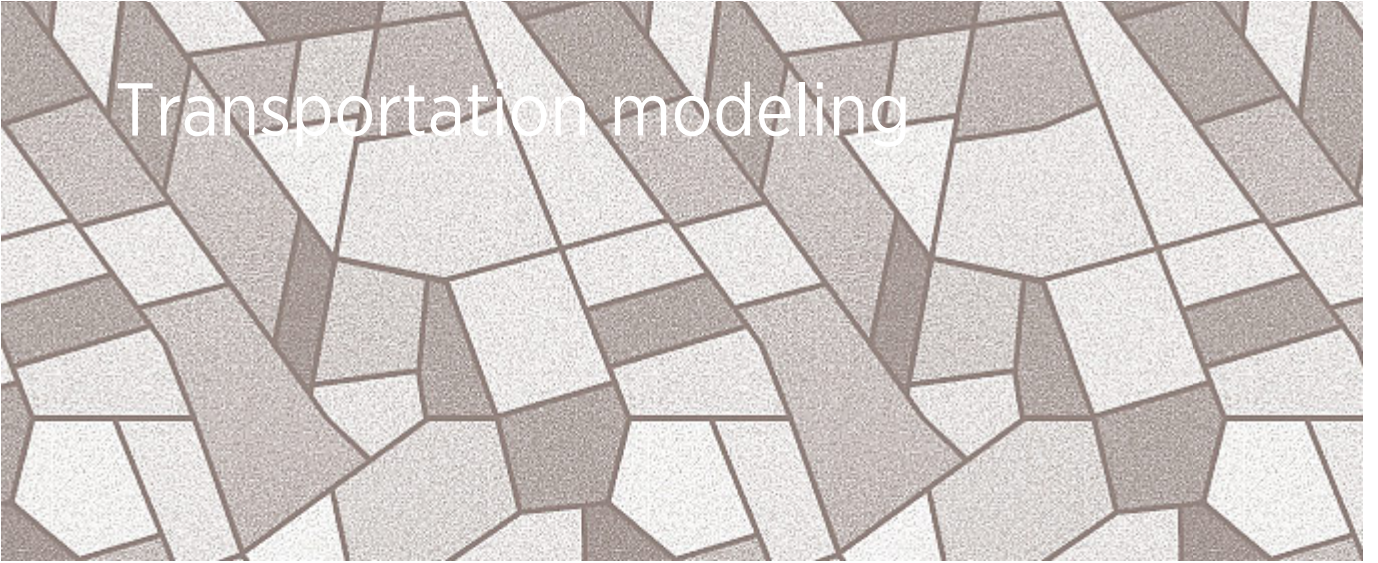




Transportation modeling
